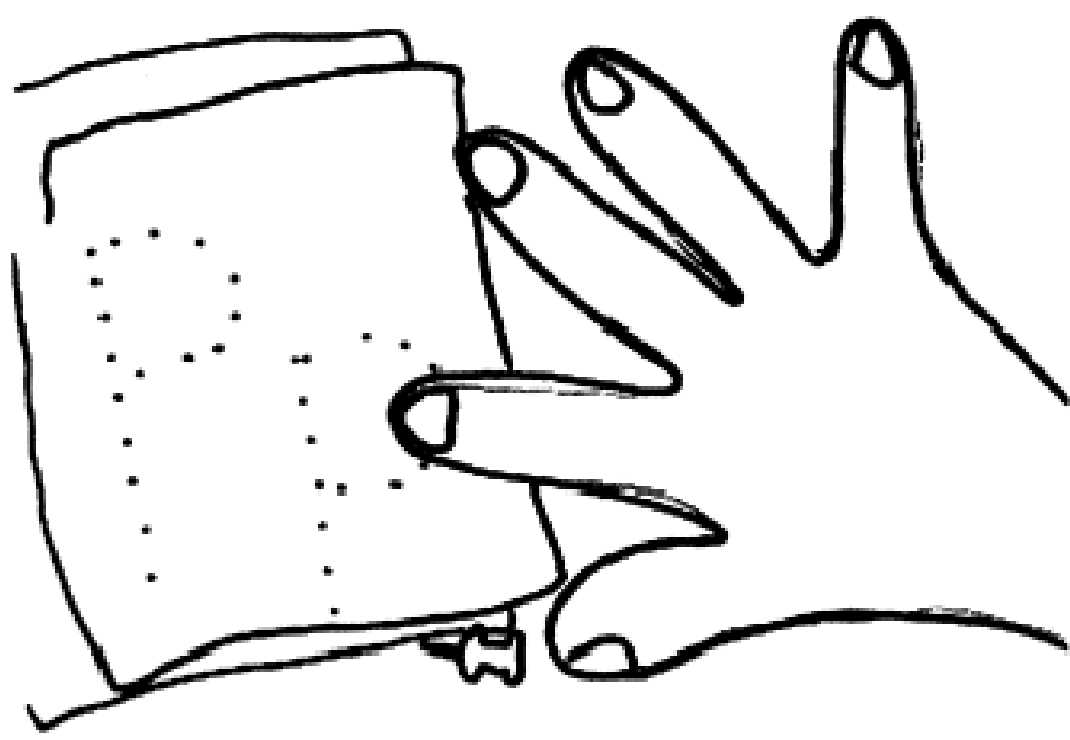

Perforations

This book contains three different types of perforating patterns (letters, words, and shapes). To use these projects, you will need to:

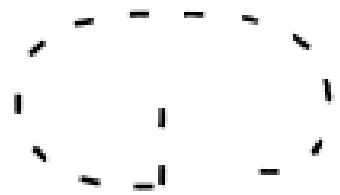
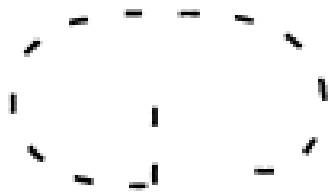
1. Make copies of the chosen perforation pattern.
2. Cut them apart so that each student has his or her own project.
3. In addition, you will also need to cut construction paper squares/rectangles to match the perforation pattern.

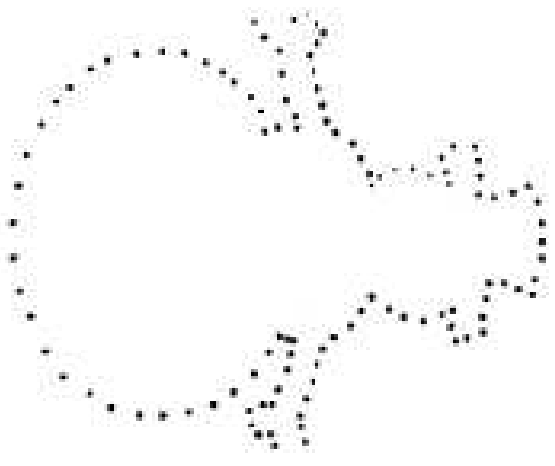
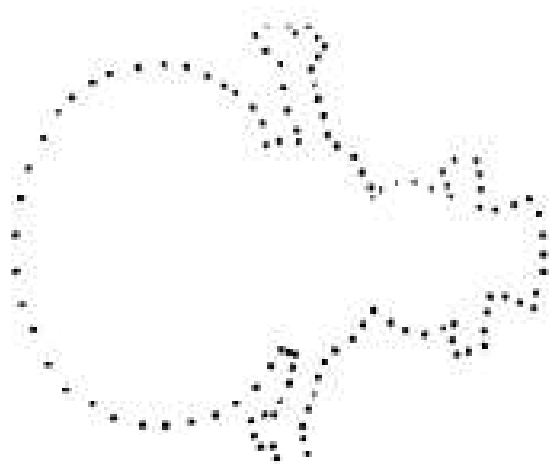
Directions for the students:

1. Get a perforation pattern and place it on top of the piece of construction paper.
2. Use a push pin to perforate the paper, following the dotted pattern. (Students may perforate on carpeted floor, foam plates, etc.)
3. Remove the pattern.
4. Hold perforated paper up to the light to view the "lit" shape!
