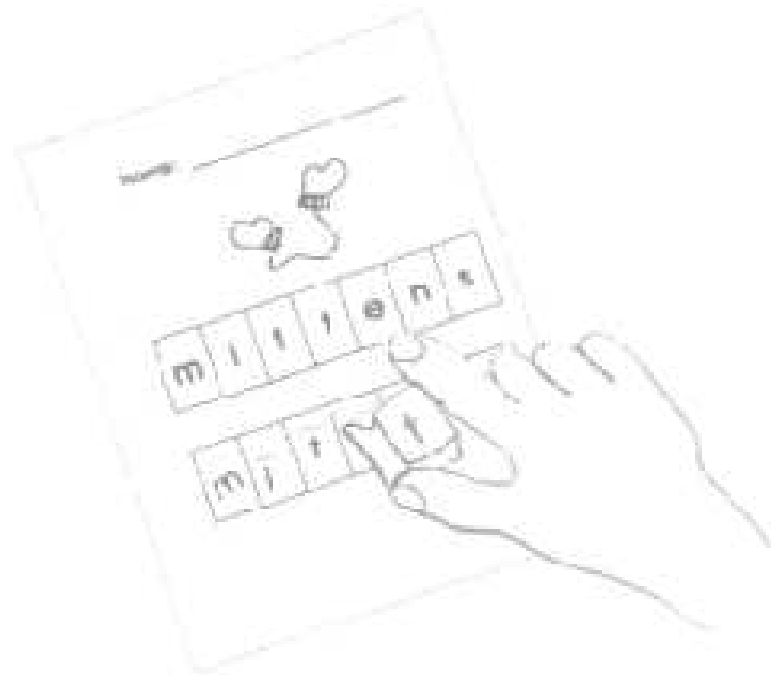

How to use Stamp Words 2

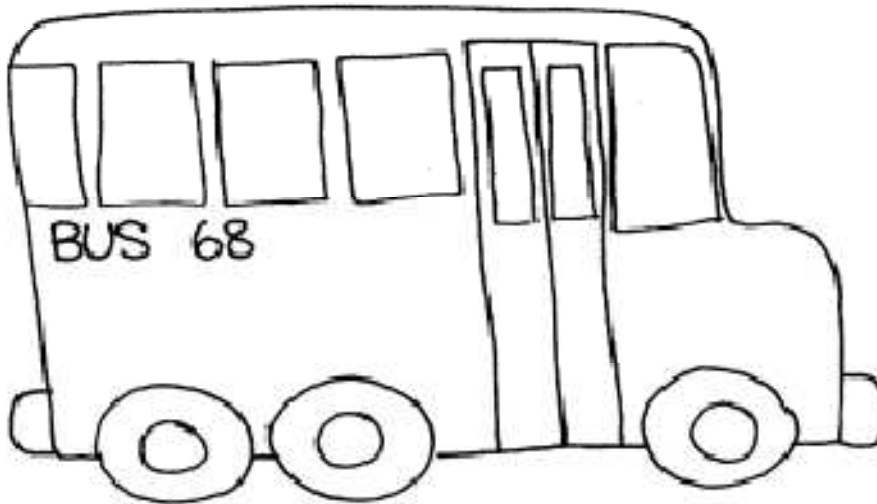
